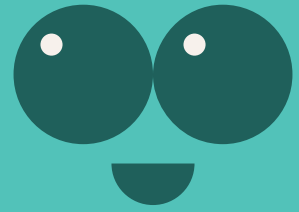


Yellow Creeping Daisy

Scientific name : *Sphagneticola trilobata*



English name : Yellow Creeping Daisy

Family : Asteraceae

Native Distribution : Invasive species

Origin : South America

Growth habits : Herbaceous plant with variegated leaves

Leaf : Trifid, serrated edges, opposite, thick and glossy, with fine hairs on the rough and prickly undersides.

Flower : Yellow flowers, resembling daisies.

Tree characteristics : It thrives in sunlight, is heat-tolerant, drought-tolerant, salt-tolerant, and resistant to wind.

Flowering period : Year-round (most abundant from summer to autumn)

Fruit period : Year-round

Ecology : Primarily used for ornamental purposes, it serves as a nectar source for small butterflies and bees.
